Cancelled checks serve as preliminary acceptance as a festival vendor.

Attention Vendors:

The Historic Appomattox Railroad Festival committee cordially invites you to participate in the 38th annual Festival to be held October 9-10, 2010. Each year the festival is becoming better and attracting more and more visitors. We hope you plan to join us at this years' festival! Below are the general guidelines and rules for participation in the 2010 Historic Appomattox Railroad Festival. Please read them carefully.

Application Deadline – June 30, 2010

Participation:

Hand crafted items, showcasing the abilities of the artisans and craftspeople will receive preference and scheduling priority. Commercially made items (i.e. T-shirts, hats, plastic trinkets, etc.) must be approved by the festival committee prior to being sold. A website or photograph of your work/items being sold and your display must accompany your application. If this information is not provided with your application, your application and fee will be returned to you.

Banned items – No exceptions:

- Yard sale or flea market type items
- Snap pops or any other item containing explosive material
- Air guns, bb guns, pellet guns, etc.
- Items with profanity
- Alcohol and Drugs
- Any other item deemed necessary for removal by any member of HARF

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Electricity:

Electricity is available, but limited to first come first served. (Based on receipt of application)

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Arts and Craft Vendors

Space:

- Approximately 10' x 12' space
- Vendors must provide their own tables, chairs, tents, display equipment and anything else needed throughout the festival. Vendors are required to allow way for the parade route and Railroad Willie Express. After the parade, your tent may be moved further into the street.
- Spaces will be marked prior to the festival. You will receive your space number at the time of registration and the day of the festival. Entrances to buildings and storefronts must remain open. No material is to be displayed or hung on buildings, windows or street lamps. Vendors are responsible for keeping their area clean and free of hazards.

Refunds:

If for any reason you will not be able to participate in the festival and you have paid your fee, you must notify the festival committee by September 11, 2010 to receive a refund. After this time, no refunds will be given for any reason. Refunds will not be given for vendors that are asked to leave the festival for non-compliance, or for rain.

Tax Collection:

VA States sales tax must be collected, reported and paid to the festival treasurer at the end of the day. Forms will be available at the festival.

Setup Information:

- You must check in at the registration table to receive your vendor space information.
- Saturday setup is 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. All vehicles must be off the streets by 9:00 a.m.
- Sunday setup is 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. All vehicles must be off the streets by 11:00 a.m.

The Historic Appomattox Railroad Festival Committee cannot and will not assume any responsibility for any lost, damaged, stolen or destroyed work, material or equipment attended or unattended during the festival. Anything left throughout the night will be at your own risk.

Failure to comply with any of the general guidelines and regulations may result in the vendor being asked to leave the festival. All state and local law enforcement have grounds to ask you to leave at their discretion. If you have any questions, please feel free to call the Town of Appomattox office at 434-352-8268.
